#### **ROAD TO THE HAGUE**

BWF task is to prosecute Lukashenka and executors of his criminal orders as citizens who have committed numerous crimes against the Belarusian people.

**Psychological** assistance to every woman who has suffered from the political situation in Belarus.

Professional online consulting (in Russian) provided to women anonymously & confidentially in one-to-one and group meetings.

Informative posts in BWF website and social media advising how to survive in stress and violence situations, methods of relaxing and mind-healing etc. We hope that our advice will help to restore emotional wellbeing and tranquillity of repressed women and those in exile (17 posts from September to December).

#### MY STEP TO FREEDOM

The core of this work is a series of interviews with women from Belarus who have experienced the atrocity of the Lukashenko regime. The stories will serve as documented evidence of the regime's crimes.

By the end of 2021, >50 detailed interviews have been collected. Most of them cannot be published for the sake of interviewees' safety. They are, however, filed to initiate further legal proceedings (see our project "Road to The Hague").

All stories are treated very carefully, and data is stored in a secure data bank.

On BWF website 34 stories are published.





Under our project "I'm a political prisoner" we tell, on our own behalf, the stories of our wonderful women who suffered for their civil position and are now illegally held in Belarusian prisons by Lukashenko regime. ### **Activities completed**

Two 40-minute films (in English and Russian) based on the interviews and stories of the women in Belarus who went through prison & torture, told on behalf of them by the volunteers of BWF, were launched on our website, YouTube channel and other social media to let the world know about the brave women who sacrificed their freedom for us.

67 short videos (1-3 minutes) in RU, EN, DE and IT were launched about each of women – prisoners.

By the end of December 2021, there are 170 complete files for women - actual and previous political prisoners on BWF website. They are updated accordingly to new information arriving.



#### **URGENT APPEALS**

BWF is publishing and sending urgent appeals to international women's and human rights organisations, politicians, political and social activists with calls for action as a response to the critical humanitarian situation of thousands of Belarusian women created by the Lukashenka regime

Our main demands:

- immediately and unconditionally release of ALL POLITICAL PRISONERS; their complete and immediate acquittal and rehabilitation;
- Prosecution of all the affiliates of Lukashenka and his regime.

Until now, 8 Urgent Appeals have been released and published, among them:

- Appeal to the women of the world to stand with Belarusian women to stop the dictatorship pandemic (2/11/2020).
- Call for support to open a trial against Lukashenka at the ICC in The Hague under the article «Crimes against humanity» (26/06/2021).
- Marking the UN International Day in Support of Victims of Torture (June 26) – video testimonies of tortures in Belarus.
- «SOS» project: video appeals by the relatives of victims of Lukashenka's repressive machine call for the release of their beloved ones (9/08/2021).
- Appeal #FreeBelarusWomen to the global women's movement, human rights groups, politicians, community activists and public figures. Already supported by several European MP's (25/11/2021).

FUNDRAISING PROJECTS – ASSISTANCE TO REPRESSED WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN

Assistance and help to women - political prisoners and their children. Money raising for short-term and long-term assistance projects.

By the end of 2021, 6 fundraising projects have been launched, whereof:

- 3 lont-term projects: «Assistance to politicaly persecuted women in Belarus»; «Help for displaced women fleeing political persecution in Belarus» and «Support for children of women political prisoners in Belarus»;
- 3 short-term projects: "Start of the school year 2021" (succesfully completed, gift certificates delivered to 37 schoolchildren of detained women); «Let's keep them warm!» money raised for 94 women political prisoners to buy thermal underwear, project closed on 12/11/2021; «Christmas/ New year gifts for children of political prisoners in Belarus» still open, by the end of 2021 money for 42 children has been transfered.

Project "THE SCREAM"

Online photo exhibition "SCREAM" gives a chronological account of events in Belarus and the crimes perpetrated by the Lukashenka dictatorship against his people. https://belaruswomen.org/en/project/exhibition-the-scream

The virtual exhibition was open on August 18, 2021 and is still running. Several photographers gave their art photos and reportage photos (ca. 40 pictures) from the peaceful demonstrations and how they were detained and treated by Lukashenko's repressive forces.

**FASHION FOR FREEDOM** 

The BWF team **call on world-renowned designers** and budding designers to dedicate one piece from their current collection or new collection to Belarusian women who face violence and repression for wearing colours of their choice.

Several collections of clothes have been launched, promoting not only the right to wear traditional belarusian colours, but also – sustainable living and mind therapy. The Belarus girls' band Kriwi performed in a concert in Berlin in the dresses of Alena Steinke, one of the designers. The money gained from sales of her collection was used for 1st September gifts to the children of political prisoners.

In order to raise more money to achieve the goals of BWF, at the end of 2021, a new great project has been launched – BWF online shop. ### Participation in conferences and visits; interviews and appeals

**Starting from the summer 2020, and during 2021,** the Chairman of BWF Veronica Tsepkalo has represented the Foundation and herself in numerous international events dedicated to human rights' situation in Belarus & reminding the international society about the atrocities of Lukashenka's regime.

24/11/2020 – V.Tsepkalo and S.Tikhanovskaya addressed the European Parliament Committee on Women's Rights and Gender Equality.

In her speech, Veronica called on the European Union to pay attention to the situation regarding the violation of women's rights in Belarus. She announced the creation of the Belarus Women's Foundation.

14/12/2020 - DEVE-AFET-DROI Extraordinary Joint meeting in European Parliament on behalf of Sakharov Prize reception – speeches of the laureats.

16/12/2020 - <u>Live interview</u> with representatives of the democratic opposition of Belarus, the 2020 Sakharov Prize laureates Veronica Tsepkalo Sviatlana Tikhanouskaya (European Parliament live).

21/12/2020 - Participation in an online-broadcast - talk show moderated by Roberto Saviano «Che tempo che fa» on Italian TV channel Rai3.

24/12/2020 - Valery and Veronica Tsepkalo visited the Belarusians, who were forced to leave the country, in the refugee camp in Mucenieki, Latvia. They brought gifts to children and discussed what needs to be done under the present conditions. Valery and Veronica gave an interview to Latvian media.

06/02/2021 - Conference Belarusians abroad. BWF representatives talked about women's solidarity and the activities and goals of Belarus Women's Foundation.

08/03/2021 – V.Tsepkalo participates in an Online event-interview «FemaleChangeMaker on Intl. Women's day» by Friedrich- Naumann-Stiftung (Foundation) with Johanna Hasting and Karoline Gil.

13/03/2021 - Presentation of BWF in the World Women's conference, Europe-wide webinar, The Netherlands.

16/07/2021 – V.Tsepkalo and S.Tikhanouskaya gave interview to <u>zerkalo.io</u> (TUT.BY) about the power of «women trio» and results a year after the elections

11/08/2021 – In an iterview with <u>Radio Svaboda</u> (Hanna Sous) V.Tsepkalo, A.Agurbash, D.Losik, K.Kalaur talk about BWF «SOS» project, support for political prisoners and problems facing Belarusian society.

14/08/2021 - Interview with Veronica Tsepkalo for "Nasha Niva" about the year after the elections and the role of women in protests.

18/08/2021 - Interview for <u>Svaboda Premium</u>: V.Tsepkalo to Hanna Sous about her move to Greece, about feminism and the Belarusian language, as well as the newest project of her husband, Valery Tsepkalo.

23/08/2021 - in Washington V. Tsepkalo received the 2021 Jeane J. Kirkpatrick Award for her role and leadership in building a free and democratic Belarus. V.Tsepkalo had very important high-level meetings at the US State Department and the Congressional Foreign Affairs Committee, where she briefed on the BWF's activities in support of women prisoners of politics and the request BWF submitted to the ICC.

27/08/2021 –V.Tsepkalo, O.Karach, Y.Mitskevich in Talk Show Deutsche Welle "Spot-on": Women in Belarus against Lukashenka.

14/09/2021 - <u>DW report</u>: project of BWF "Fashion for Freedom« with designer Alena Steinke.

15/09/2021 – BWF published a video appeal "In solidarity with women of Afghanistan"

11/10/2021 – V.Tsepkalo participated in the conference "Crimes against humanity and the recognition of Lukashenka as a terrorist" in Nuremberg, Germany. In her speach she told about the BWF's efforts in gathering information on torture and sending evidence to the International Criminal Court (ICC) in The Hague in May 2021. The participants of this conference approved <u>a Declaration</u> where the prosecution of Lukashenko for crimes in Belarus and threats to international security was one of the main points.

02/11/2021 – BWF signed the <u>Joint statement</u> of the Belarusian civil society on the political emergency in Belarus and the full number of political prisoners.

25/11/2021 – Urgent Appeal by BWF #FreeBelarusWomen addressed to global women's movement, human rights groups, politicians, community activists and public figures. Already supported by <u>I.Santos</u>, <u>G. Morawska-Stanecka</u>, <u>S. Prezioso Batou</u>.

07/01/2022 – BWF sent the 3rd letter to the ICC at The Hague with a request for a status update regarding claim against Lukashenka.





Awards given to Veronica Tsepkalo to recognize her commitment to freedom, democracy and preservation of human rights.

- 16/12/2020 V.Tsepkalo, together with other representatives of Belarusian Democratic opposition, was awarded the Andrei Sakharov Prize for Freedom of Thought (the Sakharov Prize\*) for individuals who have made an exceptional contribution to the fight for human rights.
- 04/02/2021 V.Tsepkalo, together with M.Kalesnikava and S.Tsikhanouskaya, were nominated to Nobel Peace prize 2021. As the American Newsweek writes, "these three women are nominated for their fight for fair elections and for inspiration of peaceful opposition against the Lukashenka regime".
- 17/05/2021 The Lev Kopelev prizes were virtually awarded to the leaders of the Belarusian opposition S.Tikhanovskaya, M.Kalesnikava and V.Tsepkalo. All laureates are the successors of the traditions of the humanist and writer Lev Kopelev, deprived of Soviet citizenship in 1981.
- 20/07/2021 V.Tsepkalo, S.Tsikhanouskaya and M.Kalesnikava have been awarded the Luther prize\* "Das unerschrockene Wort" ("The intrepid word") in the city of Worms, Germany.
- 23/08/2021 in Washington V. Tsepkalo received the 2021 Jeane J. Kirkpatrick Award for her role and leadership in building a free and democratic Belarus. 21/11/2021 V.Tsepkalo, S. Tsikhanouskaya and M.Kalesnikava, as representatives of brave Belarusian women, were awarded IAPC (International Association of Political Consultants) Democracy Medal.
- 23/11/2021 V.Tsepkalo, together with M.Kalesnikava and S.Tsikhanouskaya became laureates of the "Fritz-Csoklich Democracy Prize 2021«\* award named after an outstanding journalist Fritz Csoklich who was a supporter and a fighter for independent media and democracy in the Eastern Europe.
- 17/12/2021 V.Tsepkalo, together with M.Kalesnikava and S.Tsikhanouskaya became laureates of the Charlemagne Prize, first awarded in 1950 to recognize special services to European unification. The award-giving ceremony will take place on May 26, 2022, at Aachen City Hall.
